# Have your say: Consultation on decreasing the Credit Assessment Price (CAP)

Following a decrease in forward market prices, a Credit Assessment Price (CAP) review was triggered.

We have issued a consultation paper on the value of the Credit Assessment Price (CAP). This is available on the Consultations page of our website. Do you agree with the proposal to decrease the value of CAP to £56/MWh from its current value of £68/MWh?

## How does this affect me?

This potentially affects the amount of Credit Cover that Parties are required to lodge, and so we encourage Parties to respond to the consultation.

#### **Should the Credit Committee meet?**

If all respondents and Credit Committee members agree with the proposed value, there will be no Credit Committee meeting and the new CAP value will be implemented on the proposed date of **Wednesday 6 March 2019**.

However, if one or more respondents or a Credit Committee member requests it, ELEXON will arrange a Credit Committee meeting after the consultation closes to determine the new CAP.

## NEW Risk Operating Plan 2019/20 Consultation and webinar

The Performance Assurance Board (PAB) endorsed the Risk Operating Plan (ROP) 2019/20 for industry comment on **Thursday 31 January 2019**.

We invite you to respond to the consultation, which sets out our proposed plan to mitigate Settlement Risks in 2019/20.

The new Risk Operating Plan is the first plan since the successfully reviewed Risk Evaluation Methodology (REM) and Risk Evaluation Register (RER) as part of the Performance Assurance Framework (PAF) Review.

Our hope is that the new plan should provide BSC Parties with a clearer view of how we aim to prioritise Risks and Events and deploy the Performance Assurance Techniques against the 34 Risks identified in the Risk Evaluation Register.

With this in mind, and to assist you in responding to this consultation, we are hosting a webinar to explain the changes in more detail.

The webinar will be at 11:00 on Tuesday 12 February 2019.

## Update on Modification P378 'Introduction of a CM Supplier Interim Charge'

Today, 4 February 2019, the BSC Panel unanimously recommended to the Authority that Modification P378 is approved. We have committed to submit the Final Modification report to Ofgem by tomorrow, 5 February 2019.

#### **Background to P378**

Modification P378 proposes to use the BSC to introduce a CM Supplier Interim Charge for Suppliers.

This will act as a contingency fund to protect the industry, and customers, from a price shock in the event that the CM standstill is lifted and payments in respect of previous months are required to be made.

The Modification solution is based on the recommendations of Issue 76: Using the BSC to support Suppliers and the Capacity Market Arrangements.
