Reminder: Consultation on decreasing the Credit Assessment Price (CAP) closes at 17:00 on Tuesday 12 February 2019

On **4 February 2019**, we issued a consultation paper on the value of the Credit Assessment Price (CAP), available on the Consultations page of our website. We invited Trading Parties to indicate whether they agree with the proposal to **decrease the value of CAP to £56/MWh**, from its current approved level of £68/MWh.

The deadline for consultation responses is 17:00, Tuesday 12 February 2019.

Cross Code Working: European Network Codes Implementation Plan

We work with National Grid and Energy Networks Association to develop a European Network Codes (ENCs) implementation plan.

The January 2019 update will be published on **Wednesday 13 February 2019**, and will be available to download from the European page of the ELEXON website.

The plan aims to support BSC Parties and Code Administrators in managing the changes that these Network Codes and Guidelines are introducing.

On 3 March 2011, the European Third Energy Package came into effect with the aim of developing a more harmonised European energy market. This legislation required the development of the ENCs, which would apply across Europe and take precedence over existing national arrangements. The introduction of the ENCs will have a far reaching impact on the GB electricity industry, with changes required to grid connections, markets and system operation. Whilst the final ENCs entered into force in 2017, implementation activities in GB will continue for a number of years.

Modifications, Change and Implementation

P380 raised

On 6 February National Grid raised Modification Proposal <u>P380 'Revision to Replacement Reserve Bid Data</u> <u>submission deadline requirements'</u>.

Recent changes to the Replacement Reserve Implementation Framework (RRIF), specifically the Transmission System Operator's (TSO's) energy bid submission at Gate Closure time for Replacement Reserves (RR), means that National Grid Electricity System Operator (NGESO) as the GB ESO will not be able to be compliant with the Balancing and Settlement Code (BSC) obligations introduced by P344 'Project Trans European Replacement Reserve Exchange (TERRE).

This Modification proposes to modify the BSC Section Q 'Balancing Mechanism Activities' legal text approved for implementation as part of the P344 solution to ensure NGESO's continued compliance with the BSC and the RRIF.

The BSC Panel will consider the Initial Written Assessment (IWA) at its meeting on **14 February 2019**, where it will consider how to progress P380.

P363 and P364 issued for Assessment Procedure Consultation

The combined <u>P363 'Simplifying registration of new configurations of BM Units'</u> and P364 'Clarifying requirements for registering and maintaining BM Units' Assessment Procedure Consultation was issued on Friday 8 February 2019, which you are invited to respond to by **Thursday 28 February 2018**.

The combined P363/4 Workgroup identified a single solution that will remedy both the P363 and P364 defects. The proposed solution for P363/4 has four elements:

- Expand BSC Section K 'Classification and registration of Metering Systems and BM units' Section 3 criteria for those BM Unit configurations that are deemed to meet the conditions to be registered as a Standard BM Unit
- Lay down new criteria for what is considered to be a Standard BM Unit
- Change the BSC so that an application to register BM Units must either meet the configuration criteria (bullet one above) **or** align with the new list of registration criteria (bullet two above) to be considered as a Standard BM Unit
- Removing the need to apply for a Non-Standard BM Unit where the configuration is Standard but there is more than one Party involved.
